the extent that they hereby complete the account as published in the UNITED STATES ARMY IN WORLD WAR II histories. Or rather the Corps was just subsiding, not altogether happily, from that crisis, by 1 July 1943. In the field, in North Africa, the Signal Corps had just passed its first great combat test of the war.
